### **Planning & Zoning Commission**

City Council is seeking applications from citizens inside city limits interested in serving on the Planning and Zoning Commission. There are TWO seats available with terms expiring February 2025 and February 2026.

Planning and Zoning (P&Z) holds regular meetings on the first Tuesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. and work sessions the third Tuesday of every month at 6:00 p.m. or at other times as needed if requested by the Chair.

Commissioners shall be compensated for service at the rate of \$100 per month. Application forms are available in the office of the city clerk. Completed applications and financial disclosure forms must be filed with the clerk.

### **PACAB (Port & Commerce Advisory Board)**

The City Council is seeking applications from citizens of Seward *and* the surrounding area interested in serving on the Port and Commerce Advisory Board (PACAB). There is one seat available with a term expiring in July 2024. PACAB meets on the first and third Wednesday of each month, usually during the lunch hour from 12:00 to 2:00 p.m.
