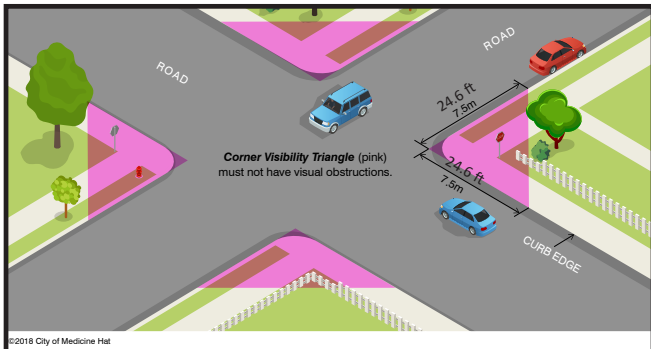


**A.** Any sign contrary to the provision of this chapter

**B.** Signs within any sight distance triangle or right-of-way



**C.** Vehicle Signs



-signs attached to, or placed on, vehicles or trailers which are parked or located for the primary purpose of displaying said sign

**D.** Off-premises Signs and/or Billboards



-except the posting of temporary signs relating to civic events subject to the limitations of this chapter

**E.** Snipe Signs



**F.** Portable Signs



-except sandwich boards  
-cannot exceed 10 s.f. per side  
-located entirely on private property



**G.** Signs that interfere with radio and television reception

**H.** Flashing and Animated Signs



-except time and temperature signs  
-except "open" signs placed inside a window

**I.** Any sign with incandescent lamp bulbs exposed to view



-with or without internal or external reflectors  
-does not include neon signs as allowed in other sections of Title 15

**J.** Banners and Flags



-banners, clusters of flags, pennants  
-ribbons, streamers, balloons  
-bubble machines

**K.** Suspended Strings of Lights and

-spinners, twirlers or propellers  
-flashing, rotating (except barber poles) or blinking light, beacons, flares  
-chasing or scintillating lights  
-signs containing elements creating sound

**L.** Abandoned Signs or Sign Structures



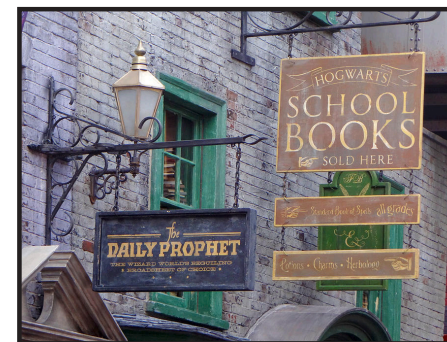
**M.** Signs Imitating Traffic Signals



-signs imitating or resembling a traffic control sign, signal or device  
-signs imitating the light of an emergency vehicle

-signs which obstruct the visibility of any traffic or street sign or signal device

**N.** Projecting Signs and Freestanding Signs fronting alleyways



**O.** Signs advertising a home occupation



# General Information

- A sign permit is required for any type of sign not listed in this brochure
- See also 'Signs Allowed Without Permits' brochure
- Only 200 square feet of signage allowed per property
- Cost of a sign permit is \$30
- Sign must be installed within 6 months of obtaining a permit or a new permit must be obtained
