Applying for a U.S. Passport

At the Seward Community Library & Museum

By Appointment Only

*Call 907-224-4082 to review and schedule an appointment with a passport agent.

*Incomplete applications, missing information, or tardiness will result in a cancelled appointment. Child and all parents must be present for 16 and under applications.

PASSPORT RENEWALS: IF you have a passport **AND**:

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- ► You can send your undamaged passport in with the application, **AND**
- ▶ You were at least 16 years old when you received your most recent passport, **AND**
- ► Your most recent passport or card was issued less than 15 years ago, AND
- ➤ You are using the same name as your most recent passport, OR have changed your name by marriage or court order, AND can submit proper documentation to reflect the change,

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<u>THEN</u> you can apply for a new passport by mail on your own using the <u>DS-82 U.S. Passport Renewal</u> <u>Application for Eligible Individuals</u> form. Forms available at <u>Travel.State.Gov</u> and the library front desk.

<u>IF</u> you <u>DON'T</u> qualify for a renewal, <u>THEN</u> you need to apply for a passport using the <u>DS-11 Application for</u> <u>a U.S. Passport</u> form. Information and forms available at <u>Travel.State.Gov</u> and the library front desk.

Prepare the following **BEFORE** you make an appointment with a passport agent:

- ☐ 1 passport photo. (do not wear glasses)
 - Photos available locally at Grant's Electronics (907-224-7015)
- ☐ 1 CERTIFIED birth certificate or naturalization certificate. (not a photo copy)
 - MUST have an embossed seal, be signed by authority and include date filed, date of birth, your full name, and parent's name.
 - o If you don't have a certified certificate, ask where to get one **before** making an appointment.
- □ Valid driver's license and/or other form of government issued photo I.D.
 - o An **out-of-state I.D.** require an additional source of identification.
- ☐ Passport application, completed. <u>BLACK INK, NOT SIGNED, NO WHITEOUT, PRINTED ONE-SIDED</u>.
- ☐ 1 check or money order (no cash or cards) payable to: U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE.
 - \$110 if you are 16 or older for a Passport Book.
 - o \$80 if you are under 16 for a Passport Book.
 - o \$30 if you are 16 or older for a Passport Card. (**NOT** valid for air travel)
 - o \$15 if you are under 16 for a Passport Card. (NOT valid for air travel)
 - *Expedited Service is an additional \$60.00 per application. (Passport Book only)
 - *Overnight Delivery Return Fee is an additional \$17.56 per application.
- ☐ 1 separate check or cash for \$35.00 per application, payable to: Seward Community Library & Museum. (no credit or debit card payment option)

Routine Service	Processing time for routine applications is approximately 10-12 weeks , door to door, from the		
	time of application.		
Expedited	Processing time for expedited applications that <i>includes</i> the overnight delivery option (2-day		
Service	guarantee in Alaska) to and from the Passport Agency, is approximately 4-6 weeks .		

• Routine Service: 10-12 weeks, door-to-door, from date of application.

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• Expedited service: 4-6 weeks, door-to-door, from date of application for an additional \$60.

Our role is limited to accepting applications under the guidelines of, and on behalf of, the U.S. Department of State. We have limited staff availability for appointments due to the many other duties that library staff are required to fulfill. Passport appointments are scheduled only after all parts of the application have been fully prepared.
