What to Donate

- ♥ Books in good condition
- ♥ DVD or Bluray videos with original cases (No VHS tapes)
- Music CDs with original cases and inserts (No LPs or cassettes)
- ♥ Audio books on CDs (No cassettes)

What Not to Donate

- No items in poor condition: No tears, moisture damage, stains, mold, mildew, pests, animal hair, chew marks, excessive dirt/dust, fading, underlining, or heavy wear of any kind
- No VHS or cassette tapes
- No series romances (i.e. Harlequin or Silhouette paperbacks)
- No textbooks
- No dated nonfiction (almanacs, study guides, travel guides, computer books, etc.)
- No magazines or periodicals of any kind
- No encyclopedia sets
- No incomplete sets of any kind

All claims, now and in the future, are relinquished upon donation.

Items that do not meet these donation standards may be discarded.
